Analysis of the Feedback Form

Questionnaires:

Most of the alumni are highly satisfied with teaching, laboratory, library and sports Facility. Alumni have given on an average 'good' rating to Canteen and Placement assistance.

Useful Subjects in current curriculum:

Most of the alumni have said that Production Management and Project Management are most useful subjects.

Some of them have also admitted that subjects like Operations Research, Tool Design and soft skill are useful.

Irrelevant subject:

Most of the alumni have expressed that no subject is irrelevant.

Some alumni have said that Maths, Robotics related, Advanced Welding, Metallurgy and Term work submissions are irrelevant to some extent.

New technology which should be included in syllabus

The alumni have expressed different views about addition to syllabus according to their field of interest and action. The major concerns highlighted are improvement in soft skills and enhanced exposure to industry along with the technical knowhow of recent technologies.

Contribution to the Department: Most of the alumni agreed to conduct guest lectures and contribute by guiding the students for projects, higher studies and placements.

Suggestions by the Alumni: In general, alumni suggested the department to focus on learning by performing and hands on experience on machine tools.

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
