- 1. Explained the significance of Japanese language in context with the job opportunities in Japan
- 2. Guided about the various levels of Japanese language and the need of these level in the working culture of Japan
- 3. Shared his views in context with the Higher Study opportunities in Japan
- 4. The cultural heritage of Japan and behavioral science behind it was explained by him
- 5. Motivated and encouraged the students to learn the Japanese language and try to go for higher study or job in Japan or Japanese organizations.



5. <u>Visit Report of International Education Fair at Pune Organized by Krishna Consultants,</u> Nagpur on 19/01/2020, Sunday

I Mr. Patil Atulkumar Sahebrao, Asst. Professor, Mechanical Engineering Department has visited an International Education Fair at Pune on Sunday, 19/01/2020 with prior permission from Principal, KKWIEER, Nashik. Following is the summary of my visit to this International Education Fair at Crowne Plaza, Near Jahangir Hospital, Pune.

- 1. There are total 31 Universities participated in this education fair from the countries like USA (15), UK (5), France (3), Switzerland (2), Canada (1), Italy (1), Germany, Bulgaria (1), Global University Systems (3) etc.
- 2. I have discussed "The opportunities of Undergraduate and Graduate Education in these Universities", with the counselors of some of these Universities.
- 3. Also the Financial assistance for study abroad was available from Bank of Baroda and HDFC Credila. They have given information of various schemes of loans available with them for the students seeking admissions abroad.
- 4. The information brochures and leaflets of some of the Universities are available with me which can be made available to our students if required.
- 5. The Counselor from "University of Applied Sciences" Germany has told that knowledge of German Language at certain level is essential for the admissions in Germany. He also told that lots of opportunities in Engineering Graduate study are available at their University. Counselor has shared the total Program expenses (Tuition Fee and Living and Expenses) which are more than 60 to 70 Lakh for most of the Universities in Germany.
- 6. Coventry University, UK Counselor told that it is one of the top most Universities in UK and offering large number of Engineering Graduate Programs. The student can avail the scholarship depending upon their earlier qualifications and achievements. Also the students can work 20 hrs. Per week for earning extra money for the day today expenses apart from their regular academic schedule.
- 7. University of Illinois at Chicago, Auburn University, Alabama, University of South Carolina, Columbia, Florida International Universities are also offering the various Graduate and Undergraduate Courses in Science and Engineering. The Counselors has



- shared that the total Program expenses (Tuition Fee and Living Expenses) which is more than 1 Crore in USA for most of the Universities.
- 8. "American University in Bulgaria" Counselor has told that it is a new University in Bulgaria which offers Programs which is the combination of USA and UK education standards. It offers programs in Engineering, Science and Arts. It also offers the placements at International levels at the end of last year to meritorious students. She said that almost 75% students get placed every year from this University.
- 9. The bank officials from Bank of Baroda and HDFC Credila has shared some points regarding study loans are as follows,
 - Loan is available for both Tuition and Living expenses of the students at respective University which may vary as per University and Country.
 - Students and family members have to give bank guarantee of required amount as per admission requirement in respective University.
 - Students and family has to pay only simple interest up to completion of their study and after completion they need to repay remaining Principal amount along with the interest.
- 10. The scholarship can be availed by the students as per their qualifications and achievements from various Universities for which students needs to apply separately after getting admission confirmation from the respective University.

Outcome of Visit:

- 1. The interaction with various Counselors from abroad Universities helped us to know the current scenario of abroad education which can be shared with our students.
- 2. The financial aspects about study abroad can be disseminated to our students which were received by bank officials.
- The various scholarship schemes and facilities about study abroad can be disseminated to our students.
- 4. The International Education Fair arrangements have been observed and the things can be worked out at our institute in the similar manner if required.


- a. The situation of higher study admissions after Pandemic COVID-19


The following points were discussed by the Resource Persons,


- 1. Ms. Jayashree Raghuram, Head, Sout Asia, Leeds Beckett University, Uninted Kingdom-



The following points were discussed by the Experts,


- 3. Mr. Geet kulkarni, Director, GeM in You, Nashik


- Discussed the inetrnships availability during study as well as the part time job availability and the necessary requirement for the same.

- Shared his own experiences at Japan and explained the students about the Japanese culture, Japanese Educational System and the Industrial revolution in Japan.



- IFC has conducted the counselling sessions and guided the students for the enrollment of foreign language courses which were framed by the KKWIEER and I-Pro EDU.
- The Memorandum of Understanding is signed between the KKWIEER and I-Pro EDU (signed in from July 2020 due to Pandemic) to initiate the training of German and Japanese language training sessions at an affordable and concessional training charges in the benefit of KKWIEER students.





Specimen Screen shots of online German language of A1 level Training Sessions














Specimen screen shots of the Japanese Language N5 Level Training Sessions
















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
