One of the major events is "Vijigisha"- A state level elocution competition. It was conducted in two categories namely Marathi category and English category. For this event well known personalities in the field of literature are invited as judge. This year around 120 participants from regional colleges took part in this event. 57 participants in English category and 59 in Marathi category participated. There were 12 judges for both the categories, 6 judges for Marathi and 6 judges for English. Each participant had 5 minutes to speak in first round on their selected topics. After the 1st round the judges were made to select the top contestants from each category. Selected participants had to speak spontaneously on the given subject again in the 2nd round in front of all the judges. 3 minutes were given for thought process and 3 minutes are given for actual speech. 5 winners were selected from each category. In each category First, Second, Third and two consolation prizes of worth rupees 2000/-, 1500/-,1000/-and 500/-respectively are given.







Another major attraction is "Master Student Program". The Master Student Program is organized every year in K. K. Wagh Institute of Engineering Education and Research by ISTE student's chapter since 2003 and this year it marked its 14th year of success. This program has a theme and every years new theme is introduced. Some of the covered themes so fm are-"Paper presentation", "How to become a successful Engineer", "Innovation", "Engineer's Arsenal", "Digital Engineers". Every theme is broadly classified into fourteen subtopics which were presented by fourteen students selected from various department of second year engineering as a speaker. They were mentor by a group of fourteen students final and third year. The program was conducted for the entire day and it provides an entire spectrum of topics which includes 14 different topics delivered by 14 speakers each concentrating on the various facets of the given theme.

This year, the committee has more and grander hopes of MSP reaching out to more students and influencing the lives of all who participate.

Since last 13 years ISTE is organizing Vijigisha – A state level elocution competition at Nashik. It was the first time Vijigisha was organized in other city.

The competition was organized in two languages namely, English and Marathi.

Mrs. Savita Datar (Sr. Teacher, L. N. S. High School, Jalgaon.), Mrs. Asha Kulkarni (Retd. Teacher, R. R. High School), Mrs. Sonali Rembothkar (I/c Vice-Principal, R. R.
