



NSS Regular Activity Report for AY2021-22

1. On 21st June 2021 7th International Yoga Day was celebrated in an Online mode for all students and staff. In this program Yogshikshak Shri. Sudhir Ugale demonstrated yoga postures, pranayam and prayer. The dignitaries such as Principal Dr. K. N. Nandurkar, Prof. P.T.Kadve, Dr. K. S. Jain were present at the yoga session. More than 370 students and staff were participated in this program.
2. Eco-Friendly Ganesh Idol making workshop is organised on 20/8/2021 in an Online mode for College and school students. For this workshop organisers provided Shadumati, wooden base to all registered students; around 1550 students participated in this workshop.
