



NSS Special Camp Report for AY2019-20

NSS Special camp of institute for AY2019-20 was organized in the adopted village, Mohgaon-Babhaleshwar, Tal. & Dist. Nashik from 22nd Dec to 29th Dec 2019. Daily schedule of the camp was divided into three sessions as:

- 1) Morning Session (06:00am to 12:30pm): Yoga, Prayer, Tea, Breakfast, Street Play, Rally, Survey, Shramdan, etc.
- 2) Afternoon Session (12:30pm to 05:30pm): Lunch, Expert Talk, Field Visit, Group Discussion, etc.
- 3) Evening Session (05:30pm to 09:30pm): Tea, Meeting, Dinner, Culteral Program, NSS Diary Writing, etc.

DAY 1 (Sunday, 22/12/2019):

All NSS volunteers arrived at Mohgaon-Babhaleshwar on 22/12/2019 at 01:30pm. They cleaned the place of accomodation in camp and made necessary arrangements for accommodation. They set up NSS camp office. Thereafter NSS Program Officer Prof. Swanand Dongare conducted a meeting of NSS volunteers in which he briefed about daily schedule of camp along with all disciplinary guidelines. He appealed volunteers for the smooth and successful conduction of camp. Then volunteers shared their ideas to be implemented during camp. Few volunteers shared ideas regarding effective use of smart phones and laptops for daily report keeping. Thereafter volunteers prepared a plan of activities to be performed in camp. For effective implementation of these activities, the volunteers were divided into seven teams namely Raigad, Rajgad, Sinhgad, Janjira, Panhala, Pratapgad and Purandar. A day wise schedule of various activities along with teams assigned to these activities was prepared. Thereafter volunteers made survey for all facilities and scope of work in village. They invited villagers for inaugural function of camp to be held on next day. Thus all the planning of camp was done on first day.

DAY 2 (Monday, 23/12/2019):

NSS volunteers performed yoga in morning followed by prayer. After breakfast, volunteers organized a rally in village to invite villagers for inaugural function of camp. The inaugural function of camp was organized in Hanuman temple in village. Mr. Shekhar Gaikwad (Founder of "Aapal Paryawaran" NGO) and Mr. Akshay Jagdale (NSS volunteer participated in Republic Day Parade at Delhi) were the chief guests for inaugural function. Mrs. Mangal Pagare (Sarpanch, Mohgaon-Babhaleshwar), Mr. Shreepat Tile (Grampanchayat Member), Mr. Sachin Tile (Grampanchayat Member), Mr. Dnyaneshwar Bhor (Gramsevak), Prof. Dr. S. S Sane (Vice Principal, KKWIEER) and villagers were present for this function. Prof. Dr. Sane delivered welcome speech. Mr. Gaikwad briefed about role of NSS volunteers in societal development. Mr. Akshay Jagdale discussed his experience about Republic Day Parade. Mr. Bhor brief about activities and tasks that can be performed for the development of village during camp. Prof. Dongare proposed vote of thanks. After lunch and rest, an



expert talk of Mr. Akshay Jagdale was organized on topic “Personality Development through NSS”. The alumni of institute and Ex. NSS volunteers Mr. Roshan Shewale, Mr. Rahul Daware, Mr. Sanjay Singh and Mr. Shubham Bhosale interacted with NSS volunteers and explained role of NSS in overall development. Thereafter tea break, a field visit was organized at K. K. Wagh farm where the farm incharge Mr. Anil Sonwane provided information about various plants and crops cultivated in farm. Prof. Dongare had a meeting with volunteers to take review of day and to plan next day activities. Volunteers noted down the activities and tasks performed throughout the day in NSS diary.

DAY 3 (Tuesday, 24/12/2019):

Day started with yoga and prayer. After breakfast, volunteers organized a rally in village to create awareness about cleanliness, hygiene and water conservation. Thereafter volunteers cleaned the public places like smashan bhumi, public water sources and temples. An expert talk of Mr. Mahendra Mahajan (Employee of Sakal Media Group) was organized in afternoon. He expressed his views on “Social Responsibility of NSS Volunteer”. Thereafter volunteers practiced cultural program and street plays to be performed. Volunteers discussed the activities performed throughout the day and noted down same in NSS diary. They planned activities and tasks to be performed on next day.

DAY 4 (Wednesday, 25/12/2019):

NSS volunteers performed yoga in morning followed by prayer. Then volunteers interacted with villagers and did survey related to family members, government schemes, economical aspects, etc. Thereafter volunteers cleaned the playground of Z.P. school and prepared it for various games. They also dug pits to plant saplings in school. After lunch, an interactive session of Mr. Sachin Giri (Environment Activist) and Mr. Jitendra Bhawe (Social Worker) was organized for volunteers. Mr. Giri provided information about various snakes and imparted a message “Save Snakes, Save Nature”. Mr. Bhawe briefed about his various social activities and rehabilitation of mentally retarded and orphan girls. Volunteers practiced street play to be performed on next day. Thereafter Prof. Dongare had a meeting with volunteers to take review of day and to plan next day activities. Volunteers noted down the activities and tasks performed throughout the day in NSS diary.

DAY 5 (Thursday, 26/12/2019):

Day started with yoga and prayer. Thereafter volunteers again interacted with villagers and continued with survey of village. Volunteers also performed street play to create awareness about “Gender Equality”. They dug near about 70 pits beside main road to plant saplings. A field visit was organized near the “Darna” river bed. Volunteers practiced street plays and cultural program in the evening. NSS Nashik district coordinator Prof. Ravindra Ahire surprisingly visited camp along with his team in the evening. He took overview of camp and motivated volunteers. Volunteers discussed the activities performed throughout the day and



noted down same in NSS diary. They planned activities and tasks to be performed on next day.

DAY 6 (Friday, 27/12/2019):

NSS volunteers performed yoga in morning followed by prayer. Thereafter volunteers performed street plays related to “Superstitions” and Importance of Literacy”. They dug around 30 additional pits in village to plant saplings. In the afternoon, volunteers performed a work related to water conservation in which a break water structure was constructed to stop water flow of a canal. Post lunch and rest, an expert talk of Mr. Somnath Kekan (Town Planner, Govt. of Maharashtra) was organized. He guided the volunteers about development of village with the help of various government schemes. Thereafter volunteers did rehearsal of cultural program to be performed on next day. A meeting was organized to take review of day and to plan next day activities. Volunteers noted down the activities and tasks performed throughout the day in NSS diary.

DAY 7 (Saturday, 28/12/2019):

Day started with yoga and prayer. Thereafter volunteers performed street plays to create awareness about “Women Empowerment” and “Road Safety”. Another breakwater structure was constructed to stop water flow of another canal and to increase water level of natural water sources. After lunch, an expert talk of Prof. Dr. Niwas Patil (Astronomer) on topic “Eclipses and Superstitions” was organized. To provide a platform to showcase their talents, a cultural program was organized for NSS volunteers. They performed drama, dance and also sang songs in this cultural program. Volunteers discussed the activities performed throughout the day and noted down same in NSS diary. They planned the valedictory function of camp to be held on next day.

DAY 8 (Sunday, 29/12/2019):

On the last day, a valedictory function of camp was organized in Hanuman temple in village. Mr. Shreepat Tile (Grampanchayat Member), Mr. Sachin Tile (Grampanchayat Member), Employees of Grampanchayat and villagers were present for this function. They appreciated and praised volunteers for their efforts towards development of village. Some of the volunteers expressed their experiences about camp. Prof. Dongare expressed his gratitude towards K. K. Wagh Education Society, Institute, Grampanchayat and all villagers for their support and cooperation to organize this camp. The camp was concluded by planting saplings in village as memory of this NSS special camp.
