

NSS Special Camp Report for AY2021-22


NSS Special camp of institute for AY2021-22 was organized in the adopted village, Mohgaon-Babhaleshwar, Tal. & Dist. Nashik from 27th Feb to 6th March 2022. Daily schedule of the camp was divided into three sessions as:


- 1) Morning Session (06:00am to 12:30pm): Yoga, Prayer, Tea, Breakfast, Street Play, Rally, Survey, Shramdan, etc.
- 2) Afternoon Session (12:30pm to 05:30pm): Lunch, Expert Talk, Field Visit, Group Discusion, etc.
- 3) Evening Session (05:30pm to 09:30pm): Tea, Meeting, Dinner, Culteral Program, NSS Diary Writing, etc.

DAY 1 (Sunday, 27/02/2022):

All NSS volunteers arrived at Mohgaon-Babhaleshwar on 27/02/2022 at 01:30pm. They cleaned the place of accomodation in camp and made necessary arrangements for accommodation. They set up NSS camp office. Thereafter NSS Program Officer Prof. Swanand Dongare conducted a meeting of NSS volunteers in which he briefed about daily schedule of camp along with all disciplinary guidelines. He appealed volunteers for the smooth and successful conduction of camp. Then volunteers shared their ideas to be implemented during camp. Few volunteers shared ideas regarding effective use of smart phones and laptops for daily report keeping. Thereafter volunteers prepared a plan of activities to be performed in camp. For effective implementation of these activities, the volunteers were divided into six teams namely Raigad, Pratapgad, Ratangad, Janjira, Sinhgad and Kondhana. A day wise schedule of various activities along with teams assigned to these activities was prepared. Thereafter volunteers made survey for all facilities and scope of work in village. They invited villagers for inaugural function of camp to be held on next day.








DAY 2 (Monday, 28/02/2022):

NSS volunteers performed yoga in morning followed by prayer. After breakfast, volunteers organized a rally in village to invite villagers for inaugural function of camp. The inaugural function of camp was organized in Kanifnath temple in village. Mr. Maheshkumar Upasani (Social Worker and Corona Warrior) was the chief guest for inaugural function. Mrs. Bhagyashri Tile (Sarpanch, Mohgaon-Babhaleshwar), Mr. Yogesh Tile (Grampanchayat Member), Mrs. Surekha Tile (Grampanchayat Member), Mr. Dnyaneshwar Bhor (Gramsevak), Prof. Dr. K. N. Nandurkar (Principal, KKWIEER) and villagers were present for this function. Prof. Nandurkar delivered welcome speech. Mr. Upasani briefed work of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in socital development. Mr. Bhor brief about activities and tasks that can be performed for the development of village during camp. Prof. Dr. N. B. Gurule proposed vote of thanks. After inaugeral function, volunteers cleaned Shiva temple and Darana riverbed. After lunch and rest, Prof. J. P. Shah dicsussed about "Recent Technilogies for Societal Development".



Thereafter tea break, all groups decided their topic for street play. Prof. Dongare had a meeting with volunteers to take review of day and to plan next day activities. Volunteers noted down the activities and tasks performed throughout the day in NSS diary.















DAY 3 (Tuesday, 01/03/2022):

Day started with yoga and prayer. After breakfast, volunteers created awareness about cleanliness, hygiene and organ donation among villagers. Volunteers provided service at Shiva temple on occasion of Mahashivratri. Team Janjira performed street play for awareness on "Blood Donation". An Eye Checkup Camp was organized for villagers in association with Zen Ramole Eye Hospital. Around 110 villagers benifited from this eye chechup camp. An expert talk of Prof. Dnyanoba Dhage (NSS Area Coordinator) was organized in afternoon. He expressed his views on "Environment Conservation". Thereafter volunteers practiced cultural program and street plays to be performed. Volunteers discussed the activities performed



throughout the day and noted down same in NSS diary. They planned activities and tasks to be performed on next day.


















DAY 5 (Thursday, 03/03/2022):

A soil and water testing camp was organized by Prof. Dongare and volunteers for villagers in the evening. A meeting was organized to take review of day and to plan next day activities. Volunteers noted down the activities and tasks performed throughout the day in NSS diary.















DAY 7 (Saturday, 05/03/2022):

Day started with yoga and prayer. Thereafter team Raigad and team Pratapgad performed street plays to create awareness about "Digital Literacy" and "Women Empowerment". Volunteers painted roadside trees in village with Geru and Chuna. They digged arroud 30 pits and plnated



desi trees like Amala, Jamoon, Baniyan, etc. Mr. Devidas Phapale (Naturopathy Practitioner) delivered expert talk on "Health care through Naturopathy". Mr. Yogesh Tile (Grampanchayat Member) had interactive session with volunteers in the afternoon. Mr. Tejas Rayate and Mr. Sahil Wable performed one act play on "Women Safety" and "Transgenders' Issues". Volunteers performed drama and dance the cultural program. Volunteers discussed the activities performed throughout the day and noted down same in NSS diary. They planned the valedictory function of camp to be held on next day.




























DAY 8 (Sunday, 06/03/2022):
