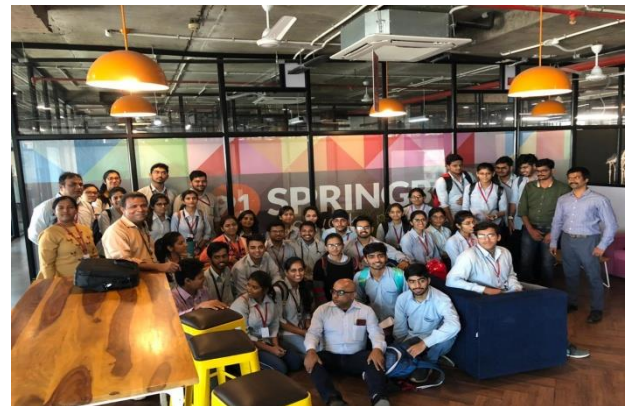

Expert talk on the Digital Marketing



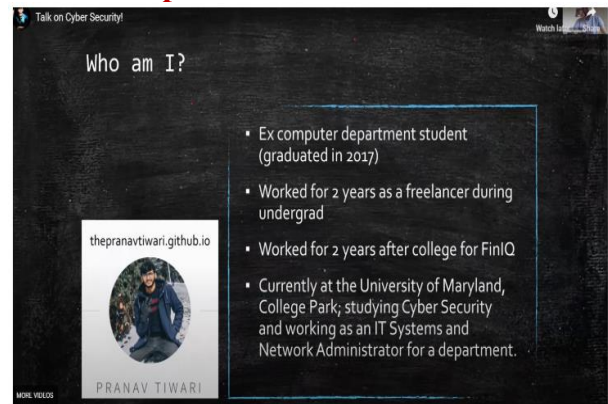

An expert talk on the topic “Software Testing” was conducted on 20th April 2020 using Zoom

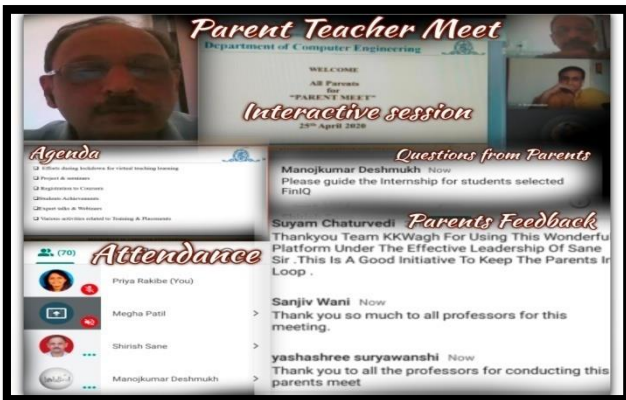

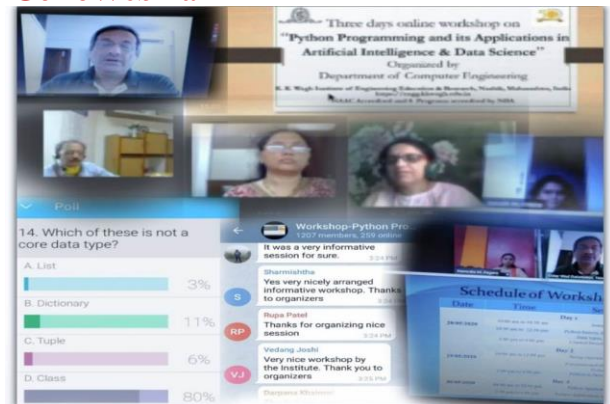
Virtual Parent Teacher Meeting using Google Meet

3-Days National Level Online Workshop on “Python Programming and Applications in Artificial Intelligence and Data Science” using GoToWebinar

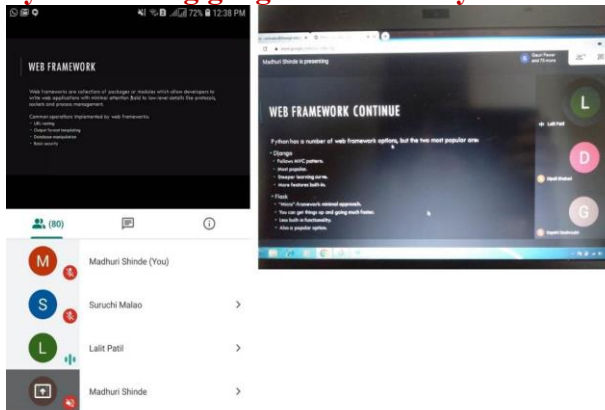

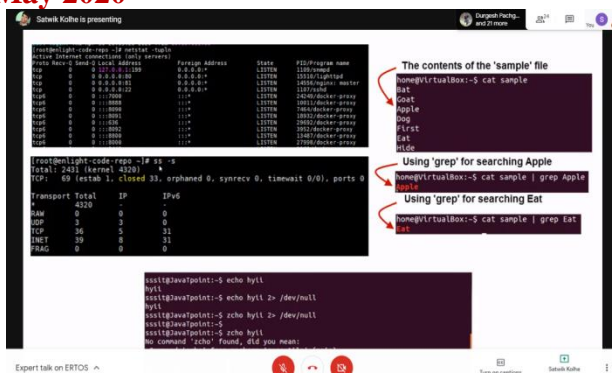
