

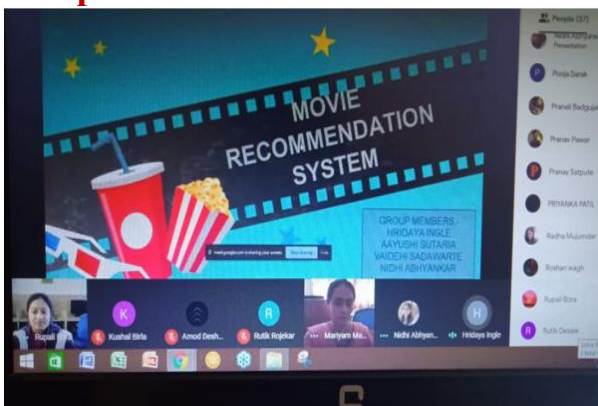


■ Online Database Mini Project competition

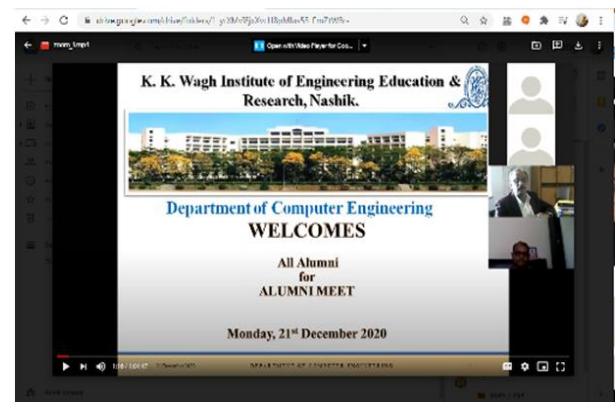
■ Online Skill Development Mini Project competition on 4th December 2020

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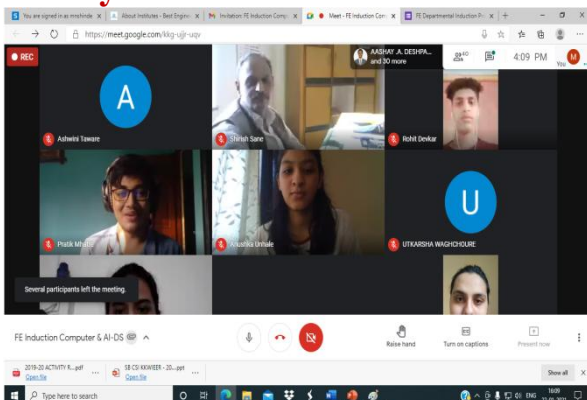

Ms. Ashwini Pal from BE computer Engineering, KKWIEER received 1st in CSI regional Essay Competition in College Category.

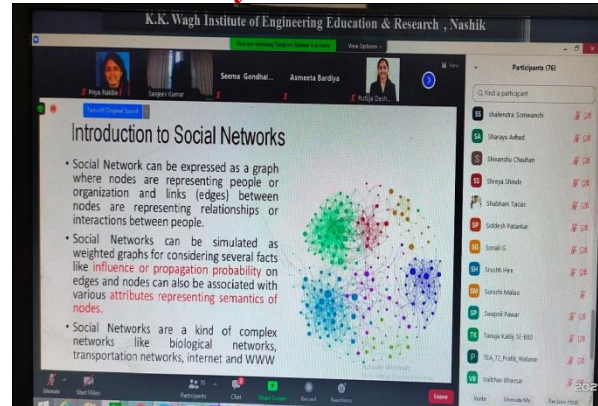
