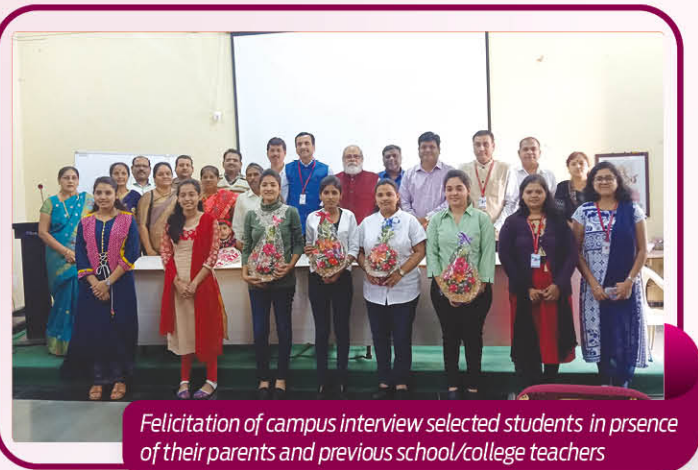

Training & Placement Cell

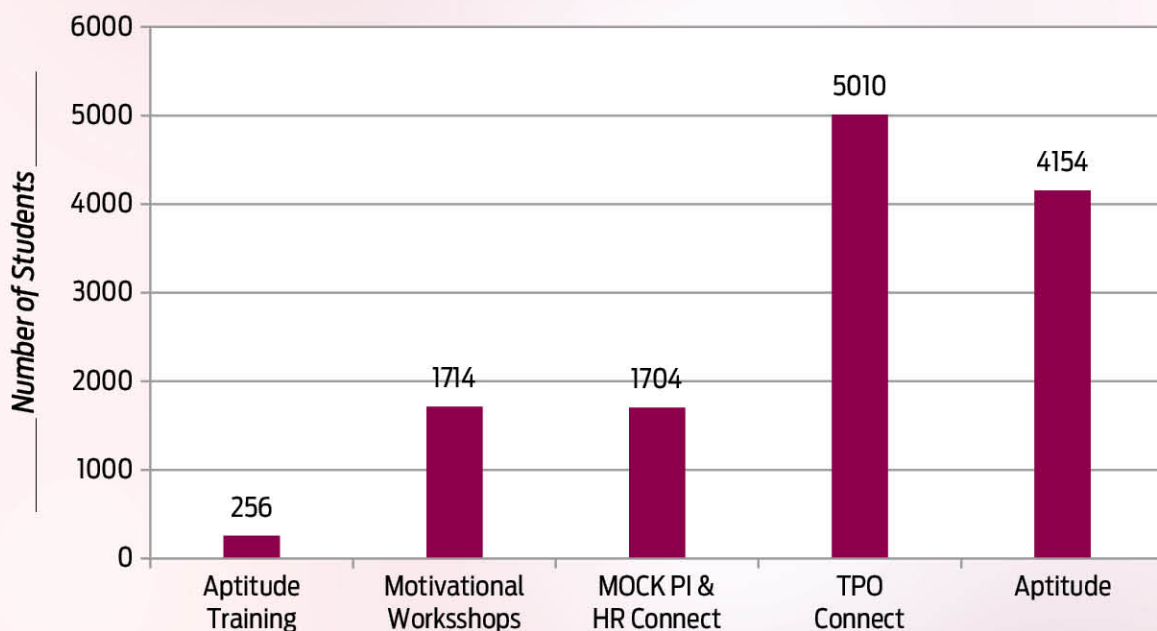

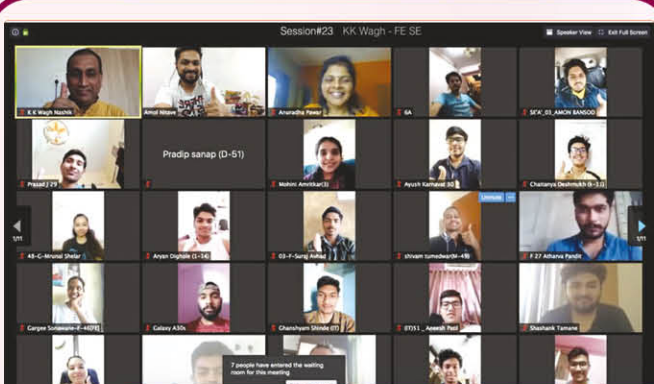

4.0 Industry 4.0 workshop for Industry Personnel

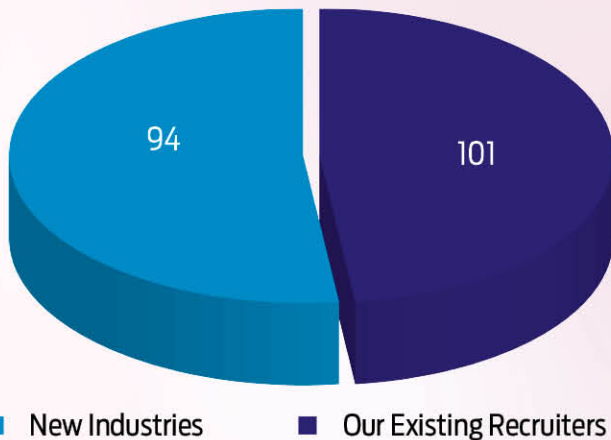

5.0 Alumni and Industry Meet in Vadodara

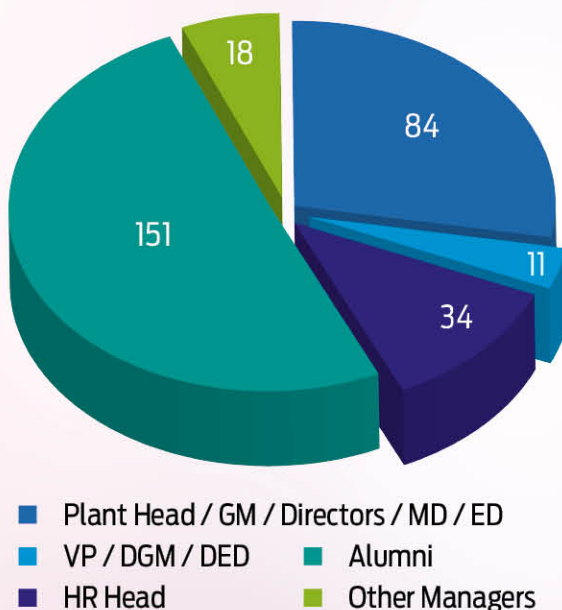

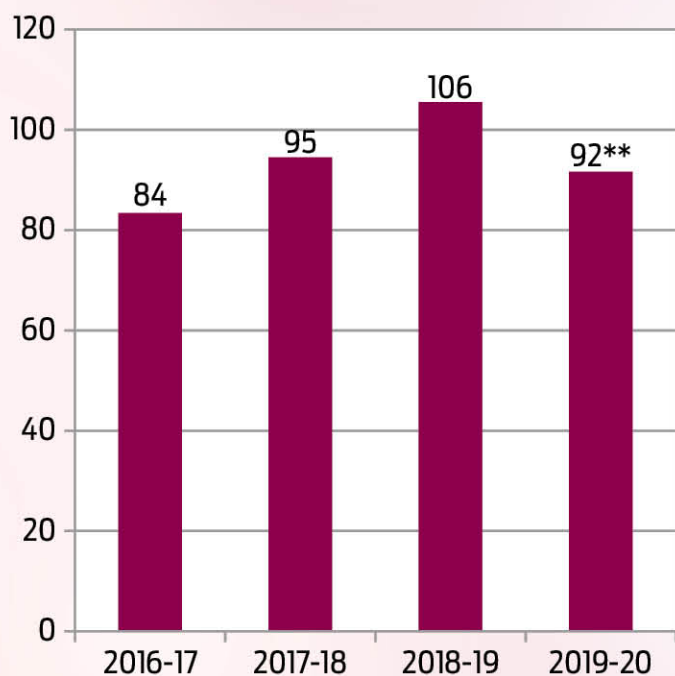

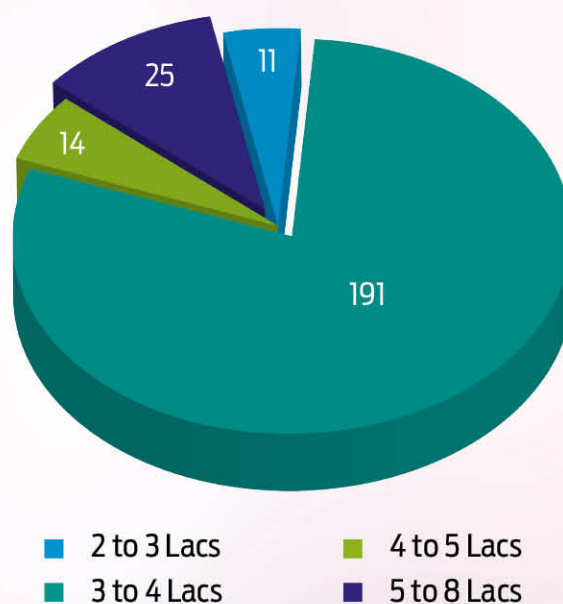
