1.0 Platinum Status to K K Wagh IEER by the AICTE-CII Survey

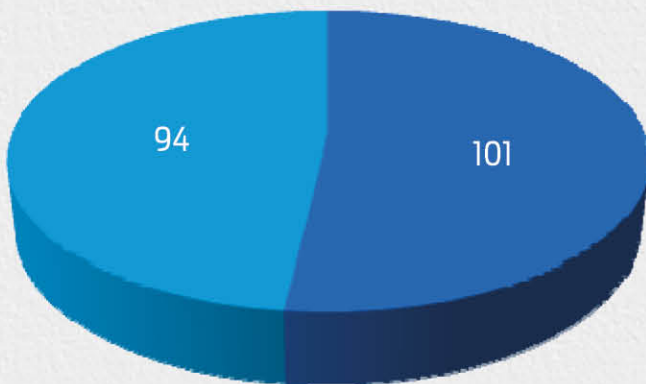

2.0 Visits to Industries

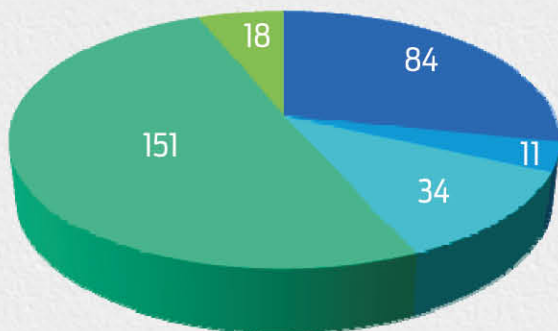

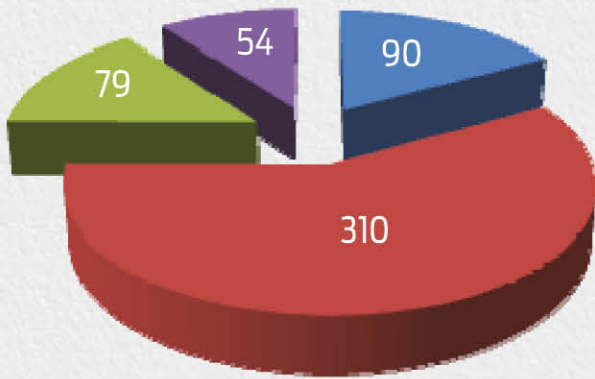

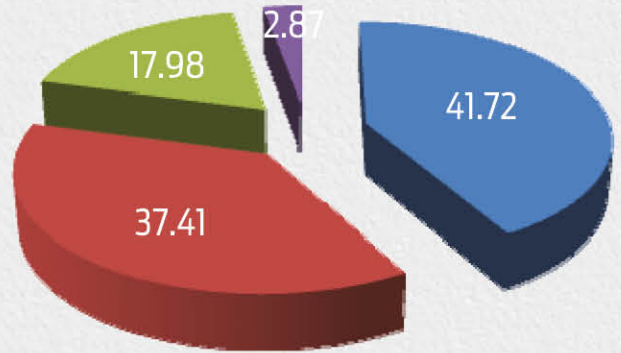


Number of Industries Visited for Campus Interview



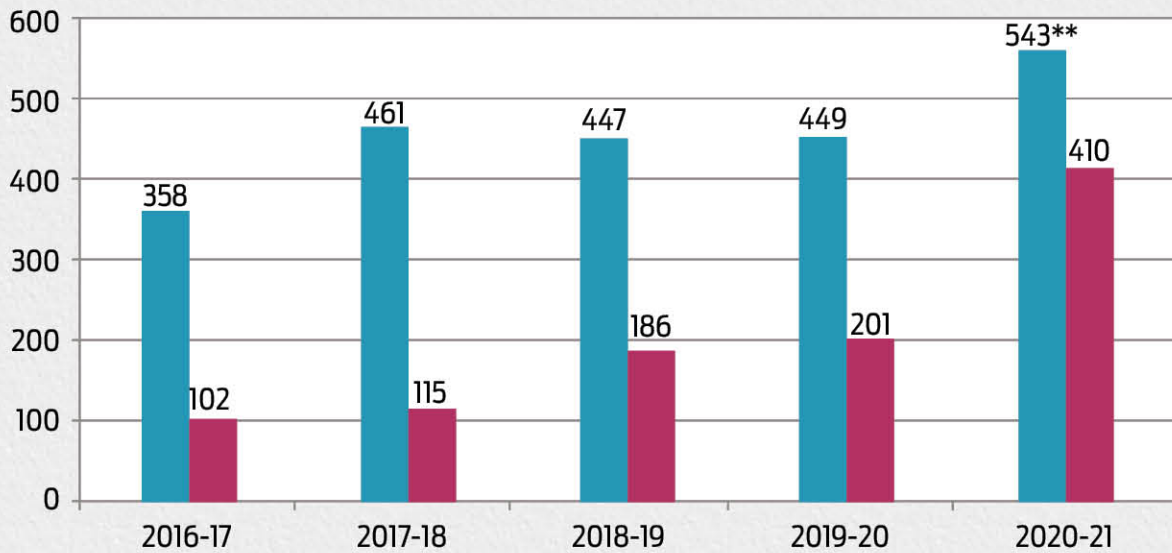

Number of Students Placed & their Package



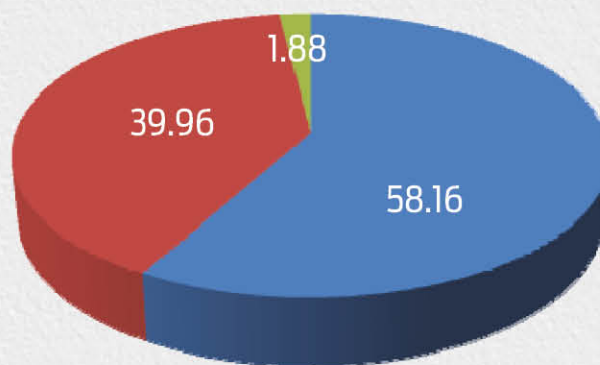

Percentage of Students Placed: Sector-wise

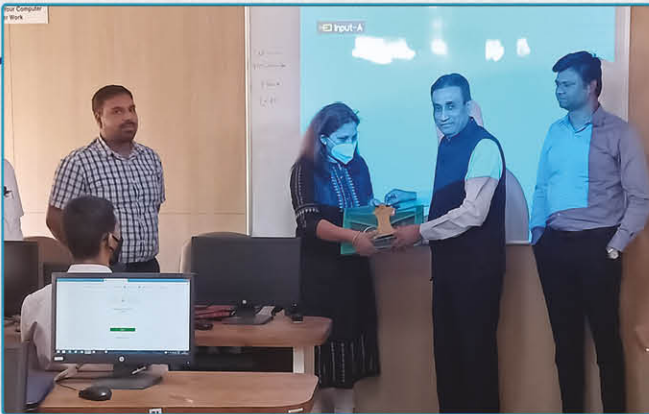
