
Student Achievements

Have we reached Peak Human? -Blog

When I refer to "Peak Human," I'm talking about the moment when AI systems surpass the cognitive abilities of the majority of humans, marking the point where we begin to lose our intellectual edge. After this, AI will continue to outthink us until it reaches Superintelligence, a far more dangerous milestone. While most focus on the latter, I believe the former is critical to track, as it could occur in months, not years.

Until recently, humans could easily outperform AI in basic reasoning tasks. The classic IQ test has been a common measure of human reasoning, though not a perfect one. Recently, journalist Maxim Lott tested Large Language Models on a standardized Mensa IQ test. For the first time, an AI model, OpenAI's "o1," scored 120—significantly surpassing the median human IQ of 100, marking a notable shift in cognitive capabilities...Read more
