Dear Students,

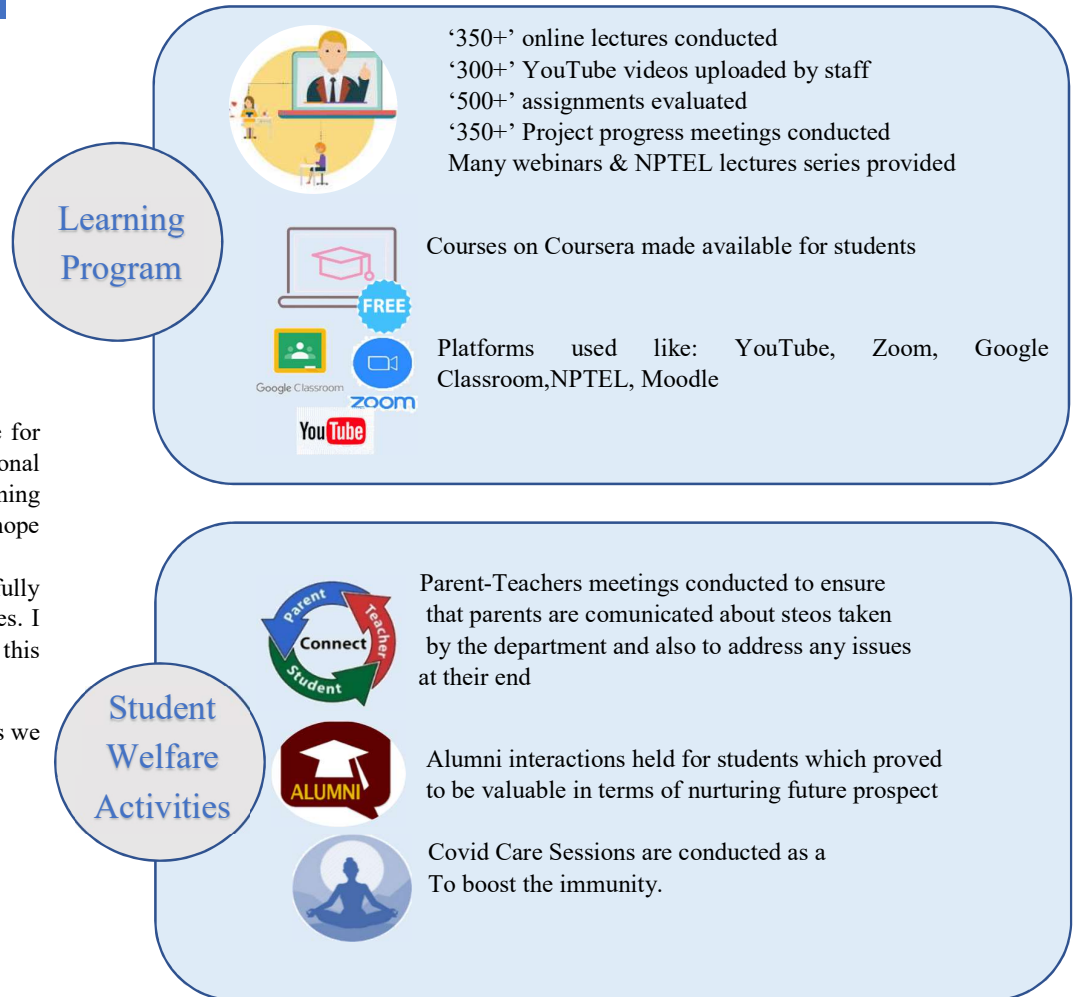

Project presentations are conducted periodically to check the progress of Final year projects.

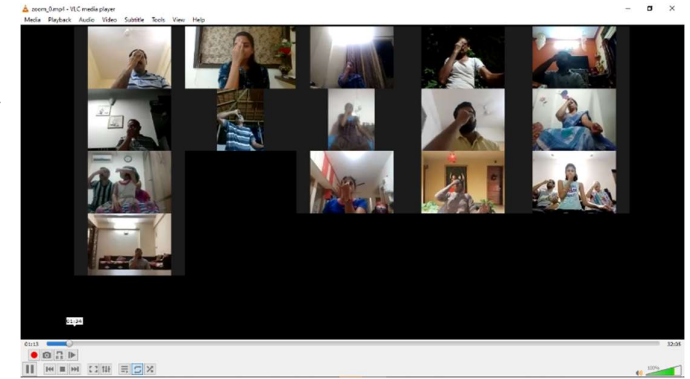
Alumni Interaction




Outside World Interaction
