



NSS Regular Activity Report for AY2023-24

1. NSS programme officer Prof. Swanand Dongare delivered an expert talk on a topic “Beat Plastic Pollution” at IRIEEN (Indian Railway’s Institute of Electrical Engineering Nashik) on 5th June 2023 on occasion of World Environment Day 2023.



2. A special Yoga session was organized on occasion of International Yoga Day in the institute on 21st June 2023. Team NSS of the institute actively participated in this Yoga session.



3. NSS unit of the institute organized Tree Plantation activity on 8th July 2023 at Mohgaon - Babhaleshwar (Tal. Dist. Nashik) in association with Swapanpurti foundation. Around 110 volunteers participated in this activity and they planted 111 saplings of indigenous species like Kanchan, Arjun, Bamboo, Chinch, Awla, etc. Volunteers pledged to take care of these plants. Prof. Swanand Dongare and Prof. Sachin Kakde coordinated this activity. Sarpanch of Mohgaon - Babhaleshwar, Mrs. Surekha Tile and gram panchayat member Mr. Yogesh Tile were present for this activity. After this tree plantation activity, volunteers visited the “Vankranti” project at Jakhori (Tal. Dist. Nashik) in which villagers have created a dense forest on the barren land having around 7000 fruit plants.





4. NSS unit of KKWIEER organized an expert lecture of Mr. Amrut Bang (Program Director - NIRMAN and Joint Director - SEARCH) for NSS volunteers on topic “Importance of Social Service in Life” on 12th July 2023.



5. NSS unit of KKWIEER received a “Special Appreciation Award” from Government Blood Bank, Nashik for organizing Blood Donation camps and donating 400+ blood bags in AY:2022-23. The award function was organized on 25th July 2023 at Indian Medical Association Hall, Nashik. Prof. Swanand Dongare and NSS volunteers collected this award.



6. NSS unit of KKWIEER organized a guidance session on New Voter Registration and demonstration of Voter Helpline App on 2nd August 2023 in the institute. This session was conducted by officers of Election Commission Office of 123 Nashik East Assembly Constituency.





7. NSS unit of KKWIEER organized New Voter Registration drive for newly admitted first year students of the institute on 14th August 2023. NSS volunteers guided and helped around 300 newly admitted first year students for their online registration as new voters using Voter Helpline App.



8. NSS unit of KKWIEER organized “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign under Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav on 14th August 2023 in the institute campus. NSS volunteers took selfies with tricolour flag and uploaded on GoI web portal.



9. NSS unit of KKWIEER established “Birthday Blood Donars’ Club” in the institute in association with Government Blood Bank, Nashik. This club was inaugurated on 2nd September 2023 by hands of regional blood transfusion officer Dr. Purushottam Puri and principal Dr. K. N. Nandurkar. This club was established with a mission “No Shortage and No Wastage of Blood”. The blood donation van is made available for donors in the institute campus daily in between 12:30 pm to 2:00 pm.





10. Around 100 NSS volunteers actively participated in “Eco Friendly Ganesh Idol Making Workshop” jointly organised by K. K. Wagh Education Society, Nashik, SMILE and SPINACH on 3rd September 2023 in the institute campus. Around 2500 students of various schools and colleges in Nashik participated in this workshop. NSS volunteers guided and helped participants in making Ganesh Idol with eco friendly shadoo clay.



11. NSS unit of KKWIEER organised a blood donation camp on occasion of K. K. Wagh Ganesh Festival - 2023 in the institute campus on 22nd September 2023 in association with Government Blood Bank, Nashik. Total 61 bags of blood were collected in this camp.



12. NSS day was celebrated on 25th September 2023 by the NSS unit KKWIEER in the institute. Dr. Purushottam Puri (Regional Blood Transfusion Officer, Nashik) was the chief guest for this function. He guided the NSS volunteers about the Benefits of Blood Donation. Prof. Swanand Dongare conducted an orientation session of new NSS volunteers. 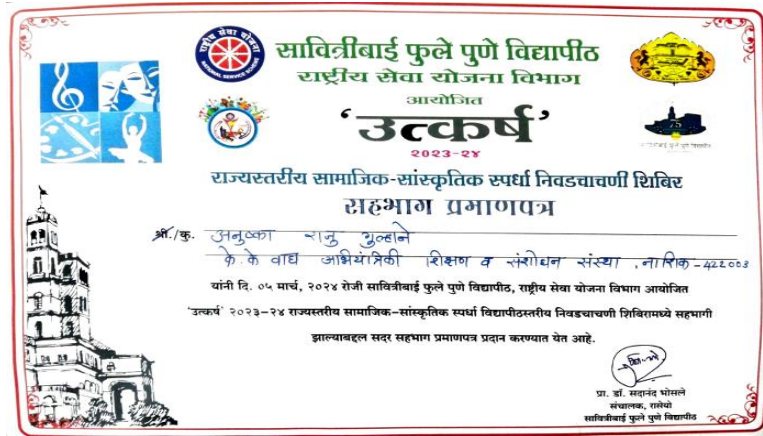
